Proclamation

Whereas, 1 in every 3 women and every 1 in 4 men have been victims of some form of Domestic Violence by an intimate partner in their lifetime. Nearly 20 people per minute are physically abused by an intimate partner in the United States, and, approximately 15.5 million children are exposed to domestic violence every year;

Whereas, when a family member is abused, it can have long-term damaging effects on the victim that also leave a mark on family, friends, and the community at large;

Whereas, families are indispensable to a stable society, and they should be a place of support to instill responsibility and values in the next generation;

Whereas, violence against women and children is a prevalent social illness due to the historical imbalance of power in gender and age; however, sexual and domestic violence are widespread and are devastating to society as a whole;

Whereas, the problems of sexual and domestic violence are not confined to any group or groups of people, but crosses all economic, racial, gender, educational, religious, and societal barriers, and are sustained by societal indifference;

Whereas, the crimes of domestic and sexual violence violate an individual's privacy, dignity, security, and humanity due to the systematic use of physical, emotional, sexual, psychological, and economic control and/or abuse;

Whereas, victims should have help to find the compassion, comfort, and healing they need, and abusers should be punished to the full extent of the law;

Whereas, victims of violence should have access to medical and legal services, counseling, emergency and transitional housing, and other supportive services so that they can safely escape the cycle of abuse;

Whereas, we encourage domestic and sexual violence victims and their families to seek assistance from appropriate victims' services organizations;

Whereas, it is important to recognize the compassion and dedication of the individuals who provide services to victims of domestic and sexual violence and work to increase public understanding of this significant problem;

Whereas, local programs, state coalitions, national organizations, and other agencies nationwide are committed to increasing public awareness of domestic and sexual violence and its prevalence, and to eliminating it through prevention and education;

Whereas, the Township of North Bergen has a moral obligation to work to prevent domestic violence, address its brutal and destructive effects and make ending domestic violence a local priority;

Whereas, Domestic Violence Awareness Month provides an excellent opportunity for residents to learn more about preventing domestic violence and to show support for the numerous organizations and individuals who provide critical advocacy services and assistance to victims and survivors;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, NICHOLAS J. SACCO, MAYOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, and the entire BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, do hereby proclaim the month of October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month, in the Township of North Bergen.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING REMOTE MEETING PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS DURING DECLARED STATES OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 103 declaring a state of emergency as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 104, which announced aggressive social distancing measures as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic, which included encouraging employees to tele-work if feasible and limiting large social gatherings and in-person meetings such as those conducted by local government entities; and

WHEREAS, local government entities such as the Township of North Bergen (the "Township") have continued to conduct public meetings and hearings during the Covid-19 pandemic remotely so as to continue the effective administration of government and to enable the general public to continue to participate in government decision making without unduly compromising public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services ("DLGS") issued remote meeting guidance in March 2020 to provide a list of possible solutions available for local government entities to host remote meetings in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6, et seq. ("OPMA"); and

WHEREAS, the Director of the DLGS has promulgated emergency regulations, codified at N.J.A.C. 5:39-1.1 to -1.7, which establish standard protocols for remote public meetings held by local government entities during a Governor-declared emergency, including minimum procedures to be followed to provide reasonable notice and to allow public input; and

WHEREAS, On September 24, 2020, the DLGS issued Local Finance Notice 2020-21, expounding upon the emergency regulations; and

WHEREAS, to allow the Township to continue to conduct public business, and to allow the public to attend Township public meetings remotely, consistent with and in compliance with Executive Order 104, the OPMA, and N.J.A.C. 5:39-1.1 to -1.7, the Township establishes standard protocols for remote public meetings as set forth in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

- 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- 2. The following procedures and requirements are hereby adopted for the Township Board of Commissioners meetings held remotely:
 - (a) The Township's notice of the meeting shall contain the dial-in conference number and/or web address and all other information (e.g., meeting ID, password) that will be necessary for members of the public to use to access the meeting remotely and to participate. The Board of Commissioners is presently using "Zoom" audio for its public meetings, and it will be utilizing "Zoom" video beginning with the October 21, 2020 regular meeting. Members of the public wishing to comment during the public portion of meetings or during a public hearing may press "*9" for Zoom audio, or click on the appropriate "Zoom" video button to raise their hand. The Township Clerk will keep members of the public muted, except when they are selected to speak during the public portion of the meeting or during any public

hearing. Members of the public may also mute themselves or discontinue their video through the "Zoom" platform.

- (b) Members of the public may submit written comments in advance of a meeting, which will be read during the public portion of the meeting. The Township may summarize the contents of duplicative written comments, noting the name and address of each commenter for the record. Written comments shall contain the person's name and address and may be submitted via email to the Township Clerk (erinbarillas@northbergen.org) or by mail addressed to: Township Clerk, Town Hall, 4233 Kennedy Blvd., North Bergen, NJ 07047. Emailed comments must be received at least 4 hours prior to the meeting. Mailed comments must be received by 4:00 p.m. the day before the meeting.
- (c) The Board of Commissioners will not accept comments through the "chat" feature available on Zoom remote meetings, or other platforms.
- (d) The agenda for the meeting will be available in the "Official Notices" section of the Township website prior to the meeting.
- (e) If any meeting includes a public hearing, such as on the final adoption of an ordinance, all material that will be considered by the Board of Commissioners at the public hearing shall be posted on or linked to the homepage of the Township's website in a conspicuous location or as otherwise required by law. Written comments, as set forth above, will be accepted for such public hearings. If sworn testimony is to be taken during the public hearing, it shall be broadcast by both video and audio. Written public comments will not be considered where sworn testimony is required.
- (f) Immediately after calling the meeting to order, the Township Clerk or other designated facilitator shall ensure that the dial-in number or other means of conducting the meeting remotely is working. If the dial-in number or other means of conducting the meeting remotely is not working, and cannot be fixed in a reasonable period of time, the meeting shall be adjourned by the chair of the meeting to another time.
- (g) The Township Clerk shall announce at the beginning of the remote public meeting the procedures and requirements for making public comment, along with an explanation of the audio muting function of the electronic communications platform being used.
- (h) In the event the meeting is being recorded, the Township Clerk will advise the public at the beginning of the meeting.
- (i) If any member of the public is attending remotely, they will be provided an opportunity to provide public comment of no greater than five (5) minutes in duration during a public comment portion of the agenda (this applies equally to written public comments submitted via email or through the mail). The Township Clerk will ask whether any member of the public has a comment. If a member of the public provides an indication as set forth above that he or she wishes to speak, then the Township Clerk shall enable the person to speak. Such person shall set forth his or her name and address. Public comments on ordinances being considered for final adoption will be handled the same way, but the 5-minute limitation will not apply.
- (j) If any member of the public is attending remotely, and a closed session is called by the Board of Commissioners as permitted by the OPMA, a separate callin number or other electronic means of limiting remote participation shall be available so only the Board of Commissioners and other persons needed for the closed session my participate. The Township Clerk shall clearly state at what

point in the agenda the closed session will occur, the reasons for the closed session, the projected length of the closed session, whether formal action will be taken on any matter after the closed session, and that the public will not be able to hear the Board of Commissioners or provide comment during the closed session. The Board of Commissioners shall return to the public meeting following closed session to adjourn the meeting or take other action as necessary.

- (k) Any member of the public who is attending remotely must participate in the meeting with appropriate decorum. The Township reserves the right to exclude those members of the public who display conduct or make comments that are disruptive, which includes sustained inappropriate behaviors such as, but not necessarily limited to, shouting, interruption, or the use of profanity. Members of the public engaged in such conduct will receive a warning, and if the conduct continues, the person will be muted, removed from video and/or removed altogether from the meeting.
- (l) Members of the public may also be immediately, and without warning, muted, removed from video and/or removed altogether from the meeting for conduct or comments that are harassing, demeaning, threatening, and/or offensive to any person's race, gender, color, age, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, and disability (list is representative, not exclusive).
- 3. Any prior ordinance or resolution controlling the decorum of Township Board of Commissioners meetings continue to be in effect unless directly contradictory to the provisions in this Resolution.
- 4. A copy of this Resolution shall be prominently posted under the "Official Notices" section of the Township's website, and posted outside the Council Chambers at Town Hall, 4233 Kennedy Boulevard, North Bergen.
- 5. TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen conducted a public meeting on September 23, 2020 and had a second reading and public hearing on an ordinance entitled "Ordinance Amending the Zoning Ordinance of the Township of North Bergen to Expand the Existing R-5 Residential Mixed-Use Overlay Zone to the Existing C-2 Highway Commercial Zoning District to Include Block 77, Lots 34 and 35" (hereinafter, the "Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners ("Board"), as required by <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:55D-62 and pursuant to the advice of the Board's Special Counsel, Brian M. Chewcaskie, Esq., did adopt a contemporaneous resolution explaining the reasons for adopting the Ordinance, said reasons including the following:

- (a) That Lots 34 and 35 in Block 77 (hereinafter, the "Subject Property"), is currently in the C-2 Zone and is developed with a senior living and catering facility, uses consistent with the uses permitted in the R-5 Residential Mixed-Use Overlay Zone; and
- (b) That the Township of North Bergen desires to promote a mixed-use project to make this area of the Township, including the Subject Property, both consistent with the adjacent Columbia park site in the existing R-5 Residential Mixed-Use Overlay Zone, and to make this area of the Township more appealing and productive by allowing commercial and high density residential uses, in addition to the uses permitted in the C-2 Highway Commercial Zone as well as outdoor entertainment and restaurant uses; and
- (c) That the proposed zoning would allow any concerns with current outdoor uses of space on the Subject Property to be resolved in a future site plan application, during which the Township's Planning Board would consider the appropriateness of buffers, parking design and location and other issues of concern to the neighborhood; and
- (d) That the Ordinance provides for the legalization of the uses presently on the Subject Property, in a manner consistent with the adjacent Columbia park site and the proposed extension of the R-5 Residential Mixed-Use Overlay Zone; and
- (e) Many of the uses permitted by the R-5 Residential Mixed-Use Overlay Zone are also permitted by the C-2 Highway Commercial Zone presently applicable to the Subject Property; and
- (f) The Board of Commissioners will require the applicant in any future site plan application to meet with the adjacent neighbors of the property prior to the public hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Township of North Bergen that the Board of Commissioners hereby adopts this Resolution memorializing its findings and conclusions as stated at the September 23, 2020 public hearing on the Ordinance.



WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen recognize that handicapped drivers face unique difficulties in the location of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen have been empowered by

N.J.S.A. 39:4-205 to restrict certain areas for handicapped parking; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 503-93, Ordinance No. 1115-07, Ordinance No. 40-10 and Ordinance No. 203-13 establish the terms and conditions for handicapped spaces.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen that:

Section 1: One restricted handicapped parking space be and hereby is established in front of the residence of Marcial Peguero of 1453 46th Street, and Carmen Romero of 1009 87th Street, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

Section 2: The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "S 5 0 L L X" for Marcial Peguero,

"A 5 1 C E E" for Carmen Romero and this Ordinance Number.

Section 4: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31st of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

Section 5: Any person who commits a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of at least \$300.00 and up to 90 days of Community Service on such terms and in such form as the Municipal Court Judge deems appropriate or any combination thereof. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which the violation continues.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 7: If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 8: This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.

TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN HUDSON COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN'S RENT CONTROL ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE MORATORIUM ON RENT INCREASES UPON RENT-CONTROLLED PROPERTIES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, as follows:

Section 1. Background

- A. By Township of North Bergen Ordinance No. 467-93, as amended, the Township regulates, controls and stabilizes rents under its police powers in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Township.
- B. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Township further amended Ordinance 467-93 by enacting Ordinances 463-20 and 469-20, which together imposed a temporary moratorium on rental increases on Rent Controlled Dwellings until the earlier of the following: The end of the Covid-19 State of Emergency declared by the Governor of the State of New Jersey on March 9, 2020 (Executive Order 103) or by November 1, 2020.
- C. The Township has determined that the continuing Covid-19 pandemic requires an extension of the temporary moratorium on rental increases.
- D. The Township Board of Commissioners also finds that this Ordinance should take effect immediately upon final adoption, and that the 20-day waiting period pursuant N.J.S.A. 40:74-4 should not apply because this Ordinance's immediate enactment is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of North Bergen's residents.

Section 2: Rent Increase Moratorium Extended

Ordinances 463-20 and 469-20 are amended to replace Section 2, Paragraph D with the following language:

- D. "Moratorium Period" shall begin upon final adoption of Ordinance 463-20, which was May 13, 2020, and continue until the earlier of the following:
- 1. The end of the Covid-19 State of Emergency declared by the Governor of the State of New Jersey on March 9, 2020 (Executive Order 103); or
- 2. December 31, 2020.

Section 3. Penalties

The penalty and violation provisions set forth in the Rent Control Ordinance 467-93 are applicable for any violations of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 5. <u>Liberal Construction</u>

This Ordinance, being necessary for the welfare of the Township residents, shall be liberally construed to effectuate its purposes.

Section 6. Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption.
