AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN TO UPDATE CERTAIN DEFINITIONS AND PROHIBIT VARIOUS SMOKE/VAPOR SUBSTANCE USES AND MASSAGE PARLORS

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Definitions of the Township of North Bergen Zoning Ordinance is amended and supplemented by amending and/or adding the following definitions:

a. Multi-Family

A building containing five or more dwelling units which are entirely separated from each other by vertical walls or horizontal floors.

b. Electronic/Vapor Substance inhalation shops

Those businesses where customers can purchase electronic/vapor substance inhalation products, commonly known as "electronic cigarettes," "e-pipes," "e-hookahs," "electronic nicotine delivery systems" and other similar devices.

c. Tobacco or Smoke Shop

Any store, stand, booth, concession or other place that either devotes a substantial portion of its display area (5% or more floor or wall space) to tobacco products, hookahs, electronic vapor devises, electronic inhalation substances or drug paraphernalia to purchasers for consumption or use.

d. Massage Parlor

Any premises which are used, in whole or part, to administer acupressure, massage, bodywork or somatic therapy, or involving the act of holding, touching, positioning, mobilizing, applying friction or pressure manually and/or by mechanical or vibratory apparatus to body tissues, including, but not limited to, employing the procedures of acupressure, reflexology, moving, striking, pounding, rubbing, manipulating, kneading and/or tapping, or the use of oil rubs, heat lamps, salt glow, hot or cold packs, vibration, percussion, medical gymnastics, heliotherapy, external application of topical preparations, or tub, shower, or cabinet baths, but excluding the practice of medicine, physical therapy, or chiropractic by an osteopath, medical doctor, physical therapist, or chiropractor licensed to practice in the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 2. Article III - Establishment of Districts and District Regulations is hereby amended as follows:

a. 3.5 General Use Restriction

- 1) Electronic/vapor substance inhalation shop and tobacco or smoke shops and massage parlors are prohibited in all zoning districts in the Township of North Bergen
- b. 3.7 Residential Districts are hereby amended by eliminating reference to Multi-Family/Mid Rise and High-Rise buildings as follows:
 - 3.7c District R-3: Moderate Density Residential
 - 3.7c.2) Principal permitted use

Multi-Family dwellings, garden apartments and townhomes

3.7c.5) Area Yard and Bulk Regulations

Area yard and bulk regulations are hereby amended as follows:

- 3.7c.5e and f:
- 3.7c.5e) Multi-Family/Mid-Rise to Multi-Family / three (3) stories

 Multi-Family/Mid-Rise to Multi-Family / three (3) stories
- 3.7c.5f) Multi-Family/High-Rise to Multi-Family / seven (7) to ten (10) stories
- c. Table 3.7 is hereby amended as follows:
 - R-3 Multi-Family/Mid-Rise to Multi-Family / 3 stories
 - R-3 Multi-Family/High-Rise to Multi-Family / 7-10 stories

SECTION 3. Any reference in the Township of North Bergen Zoning Ordinance to:

Multi-Family/Mid-Rise shall mean 3 stories Multi-Family/High-Rise shall mean 7 to 10 stories

SECTION 4. The Township Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to give notice at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing on the adoption of this ordinance to the Hudson County Planning Board and to all others entitled thereto pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-15. Upon adoption of this ordinance, after public hearing thereon, the Township Clerk is further directed to publish notice of this passage thereof and to file a copy of this ordinance as finally adopted with the Hudson County Planning Board as required by N.J.S.A. 40:55D-16 and with the Township Tax Assessor.

SECTION 5. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

- 2. Handicapped parking spaces that are physically existent but no longer justified, with the list of such spaces attached as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wish to address said categories of handicapped parking spaces and to provide for the orderly control and monitoring of handicapped parking spaces established in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1. All ordinances establishing the handicapped parking spaces set forth on Exhibit "A" shall remain in effect, but only until December 31, 2024, at which point each will expire and be of no further force or effect unless further renewed by ordinance of the Board of Commissioners.

Section 2. All ordinances establishing the handicapped parking spaces listed on Exhibit "B" be and they are hereby repealed and of no further force or effect.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 4. If any article, section, sub-section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

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AN ORDINANCE TO IMPLEMENT A MASTER PLAN AMENDMENT CREATING A NEW ZONING DISTRICT RRC-2 RIVER ROAD COMMERCIAL 2 TO PERMIT COMMERCIAL USE ALONG A PORTION OF THE WEST SIDE OF RIVER ROAD

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Land Use Law, the Township of North Bergen Planning Board adopted a Periodic Reexamination Report of the Master Plan and Land Use Plan Element Amendment on November 1, 2022 which set forth specific recommendations for future development in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Master Plan document recognized the character of certain properties on the west side of River Road between Bulls Ferry Road and the border of the Borough of Edgewater (Block 435, Lots 18 and 26.01 and Block 440, Lots 1, 4, 5, 9, 10, 15, 17, 18, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 34 and 35) is predominantly nonresidential, despite being residentially zoned; a number of these lots are deficient with regard to existing zoning bulk standards; and there has been significant residential growth in the vicinity; and

WHEREAS, these factors warrant amending the current zoning for these lots in terms of uses and bulk standards, as recommended by the Master Plan document, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is the entity responsible for the adoption of land use regulations implementing the recommendations of the Master Plan document to create a new commercial zone district.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen, Hudson County as follows:

Section 1. Article III Section 3.8 Commercial Districts of the Zoning Ordinance of the Township of North Bergen, New Jersey is hereby amended and supplemented to include a new subsection "d" entitled "District RRC-2 River Road Commercial 2" as a new commercial zone district in the Township by adding subsection "d" as follows:

d. <u>District RRC-2</u> <u>River Road Commercial 2</u>

Purpose: To recognize the established character of the area and to modify permitted uses for lots that are oriented to and accessed via River Road to permit retail and commercial businesses. The River Road Commercial 2 District (RRC-2) encompasses the following properties: Block 435, Lots 18 and 26.01 and Block 440, Lots 1, 4, 5, 9, 10, 15, 17, 18, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 34 and 35.

2) Principal Permitted Uses:

Retail sales, personal services, professional offices, banks, and eating and drinking establishments (no drive-thru or walk up window service permitted for restaurants or eating and drinking establishments). Cannabis retailers and medical cannabis dispensaries licensed by the State of New Jersey and the Township shall also be permitted, provided that there shall be no more than one (1) cannabis retailer or medical cannabis dispensary located within the RRC-2 District and that there shall be no more than two (2) cannabis

retailers or medical cannabis dispensaries located within the Township pursuant to Ordinance No. 524-21 adopted December 8, 2021. In addition, no cannabis retailer or medical cannabis dispensary shall be located within 1,000 feet of any school.

3) Accessory Uses:

Any use customarily incidental to the principal permitted use.

4) Conditional Uses:

None.

5) Area, Yard and Bulk:

6) Other Standards.

- a) Buildings with expansive blank walls facing the public right of way are prohibited. Large horizontal buildings shall be broken into segments having vertical orientation. Architectural elements and design variation, including building offsets, shall be integrated to preclude a continuous uninterrupted façade.
- b) Side and rear building elevations should receive architectural treatments comparable to front facades when visible from a public right of way.
- c) A significant landscape feature shall be provided. Total landscaped area shall not be less than ten (10%) percent of the site area. Street trees shall be provided around parking areas. Trees should have a 2.5 to 3 inch caliper. Parking rows longer than twenty (20) spaces shall have a six (6) foot wide landscaped island. There shall be particular focus on landscaping the River Road frontage in a creative and aesthetically pleasing manner.
- d) Drive-thru lanes for banks or pharmacies shall provide sufficient queue space for four (4) vehicles at each drive thru lane without interference with on-site circulation.
- Section 2. Article III Table 3 Area, Yard and Bulk Regulations Commercial Districts of the Zoning Ordinance of the Township of North Bergen, New Jersey is hereby amended and supplemented by adding Table 3.8d as follows:

Section 4. The Township Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to give notice at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing on the adoption of this ordinance to the Hudson County Planning Board and to all others entitled thereto pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-15.

Section 5. All other parts, portions and provisions of the North Bergen Zoning Ordinance, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof, are hereby ratified and confirmed. In the event of any inconsistency, the terms and provisions hereof shall govern.

Section 6. If any sentence, section, clause or other portion of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or repeal the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law and upon filing with the Hudson County Planning Board.

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY PROHIBITING PARKING ON A PORTION OF ASCHOFF PLACE DURING THE ACCUMULATION OF SNOW

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN DO ORDAIN:

Section 1: Background

Due to the configuration of certain streets in the Township of North Bergen, there is a need to prohibit parking during times when there is an accumulation of snow in order to allow plows to effectively operate.

Section 2: Conditions Triggering Prohibited Parking

- A. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street, no vehicle shall be parked on the streets, or portions of streets, set forth in Section 3.
- B. The above parking prohibition shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased, and until the snow on the street has been removed or disappeared to such an extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.

Section 3. Applicable Streets

The prohibitions set forth in Section 2 shall apply to the following streets or portions of streets:

Streets	Applicable Part of Streets	Sides of Street
Aschoff Place	The southernmost 25 feet of Aschoff Place	Both sides and southern end of the street

Section 4. Vehicles Parked in Violation

Any vehicle parked in violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a nuisance and danger to the safe and proper regulation of traffic. Any police officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner/lessee shall be required to pay the costs of removal, towing and storage before regaining possession of their vehicle.

Section 5. Violation & Penalty

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$200.00 in the discretion of the Municipal Court Judge.

Section 6. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 7. Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR A CLASS 5 CANNABIS RETAIL FACILITY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

WHEREAS, pursuant to P.L. 2021, c. 16, known as the "New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act" (the "Act"), which legalizes the recreational use of marijuana by adults 21 years of age or older, the Township of North Bergen ("Township") adopted Ordinance Nos. 509-21 & 524-21 (the "Cannabis Ordinances"), which allow for a limited number of cannabis businesses to be located in specified locations in the Township; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance adopted December 7, 2022, the Township created a new zoning district known as "District RRC-2 River Road Commercial 2," which permits retail and commercial uses along the west side of River Road, including, but not limited to, cannabis retail and medical cannabis dispensaries (the "RRC-2 Ordinance"), but said RRC-2 Ordinance did not increase the total number of cannabis retail or cannabis medical dispensaries permitted in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Act established the Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("Commission") to oversee and regulate the cannabis industry in New Jersey and the Commission promulgated Personal Use Cannabis Rules, N.J.A.C. 17:30-1.1, et seq. on August 19, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Township's Cannabis Ordinances created a Cannabis Committee to (1) receive and review applications by cannabis businesses seeking to operate in the Township, and (2) make recommendations to the Township Board of Commissioners as to whether proposed cannabis businesses should be approved at the local level, and

WHEREAS, in order for a cannabis business to operate, it requires both State and local approval; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 17:30-5.1 requires that a municipality with a governing body express its support for a cannabis license applicant through a resolution of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30-5.1(g), the support resolution should indicate that the proposed cannabis business location is appropriately located or otherwise suitable for activities related to the operations of the proposed cannabis business; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted March 9, 2022, the Township Approved Green House Apothecary LLC's ("Green House's") application for a Class 5 Cannabis Retail license to be located at 1600 Tonnelle Avenue in the Township of North Bergen; and

WHEREAS, with the Township's consideration of the RRC-2 Ordinance permitting cannabis retailers and medical cannabis dispensaries in the new RRC-2 zone, Green House has filed an application for a Class 5 Cannabis Retail license approval, with a new location within the new RRC-2 zone, specifically at 9001 River Road, Block 440; Lot 27, in the Township of North Bergen.

WHEREAS, the Township Cannabis Committee has received and reviewed Green House's new application and has recommended that the Board of Commissioners

approve its application and adopt a resolution in support of their application for a State license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

- 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- 2. The Township recognizes that Green House will be operating a Class 5 Cannabis Retail business involved in the sale of cannabis products to consumers, and that the Class 5 Cannabis Retail location will be located at 9001 River Road in the Township of North Bergen if approved by the State.
- 3. The Township's prior approval of Green House's prior location at 1600 Tonnelle Avenue is rescinded upon the effective date of this Resolution.
- 4. Approving Green House's new application for a Class 5 Cannabis Retail license will not exceed the limit established by the Township for Class 5 Cannabis Retail licenses and cannabis medical dispensaries located in the Township.
- 5. Green House's proposed Class 5 Cannabis Retail use and location satisfy the Township's zoning and Cannabis Ordinances.
- 6. Green House shall continuously comply with the Township's ordinances, including those governing zoning, planning and cannabis operations, and any future applicable changes that may be made thereto.
- 7. If Green House is not in compliance at any time with the Township ordinances including those pertaining to zoning, planning and cannabis, and any future applicable changes thereto, the Township reserves the right to withdraw its support for their operations and suspend or revoke their local license.
- 8. The Township approves Green House's application submitted to the Township and supports Green House's application to be submitted to the Commission for a Class 5 Cannabis Retail license at the new location in the Township as set forth above, which location is appropriate and suitable for a Class 5 Cannabis Retail business.
- 9. The Mayor, Township Administrator, Chief Financial Officer, Township Attorney, Township Clerk, Director of Community Improvement and any other necessary official, officer or employee of the Township be and they are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and to take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Resolution
- 10. This Resolution shall take effect upon the effective date of the RRC-2 Ordinance.
