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WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has been engaged in a process to establish a competitive market place through deregulation and restructuring the electric utility market and natural gas market; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a government aggregator and an energy aggregation program to purchase electric generation service and natural gas pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:3-93.1, et seq. and <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 14:6-6.1 et seq. will increase competition for the provision of electric power and natural gas to residential and non-residential users, thereby increasing the likelihood of lower electric rates and natural gas rates for these users without causing any interruption in service; and

WHEREAS, under the aggregation process the residential and non-residential ratepayers may likely receive a direct reduction in their electric bills and gas bills; and

WHEREAS, the realization of energy cost savings is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Township of North Bergen (the "Township"); and

WHEREAS, the Township hereby finds that it is in the best interests of residential and non-residential electric and gas ratepayers for the Township to create the opportunity for them to enter into an aggregation agreement in order to seek substantial savings on electric and gas rates;

The Township will utilize an outside third-party consultant to be named later to receive online bids and quotes pursuant to the Local Unit Electronic Technology Pilot Program and Study Act (P.L. 2001, C.30) under the NJ Department of Community Affairs. The online bidding platform will seek bids from licensed and appropriate third party supplies. If such winning bid is selected and agreement executed, individual residential consumers would retain the option not to participate and to choose any alternatives they desire, while non-residential ratepayers would also have the right to participate.
- 3. The Mayor or Township Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute any documents necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
- 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

- 5. If any portion of this ordinance shall be deemed invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall survive in full force and effect.

COMMERICAL VEHICLE PARKING ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN that:

Section 1: Definition:

The term "Commercial Vehicle" shall mean a commercial van, commercial pickup truck, commuter van, food vending truck, limousine, motor drawn vehicle, omnibus, panel van, pole trailer, road tractor, school bus, semitrailer, taxicab, tow truck, truck, and truck tractor, or any other vehicle used for commercial purposes.

Section 2: Parking of Commercial Vehicles Prohibited In Residential Neighborhoods:

Except as provided in Section 4 of this ordinance, no person shall park or leave standing a commercial vehicle upon any front yard, side yard, rear yard, or any other private driveway or parking lot, where that vehicle is visible from the street in an R1, R2, R3, P1, or P2 residential zone.

Section 3: Parking of Commercial Vehicles In All Neighborhoods:

Except as provided in Section 4 of this ordinance, no person shall park or leave standing a commercial vehicle, upon any street, public land, avenue, road, or other public thorough fare in the Township of North Bergen.

Section 4: Exceptions to Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles:

(a) The prohibition as to commercial vehicles parking in areas provided for in Section 2 and Section 3 shall not apply to vans, pickup trucks, and other commercial vehicles that are in the process of rendering services to premises within said neighborhoods.

- (b) A property that is the subject of a variance for business purposes or a pre-existing, non-conforming business use shall not be deemed to be in an R1, R2, R3, P1 or P2 residential zone.
- (c) Rental moving trucks, utilized while under a rental agreement, shall be permitted to be parked for a continuous 72 hour time period.

Section 5: Penalties and Fines

Commercial vehicles, parked in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$115.00.

Section 6: Severability:

If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 7: Consistency:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

Section 8: Repealed:
