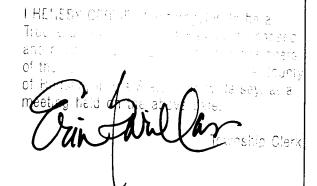

AMENDING RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE STATE HOUSE COMMISSION PRE-APPLICATION TO THE NJDEP GREEN ACRES PROGRAM FOR THE DIVERSION OF AN AREA WITHIN THE JAMES J. BRADDOCK NORTH HUDSON COUNTY PARK TO AMEND THE PARK AREA TO BE DIVERTED AND TO INCLUDE THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1814 43rd STREET COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE EMS SOUTH BUILDING

WHEREAS, pursuant to the regulations of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Green Acres Program (herein referred to as "NJDEP") the County of Hudson (herein referred to as the "County") and the Township of North Bergen (herein referred as "North Bergen") commenced the regulatory process of diverting an area within James J. Braddock North Hudson County Park (herein referred to as "Braddock Park") due to the placement of school trailers for North Bergen pre-k students and students with special needs, said use being in violation of NJDEP Green Acres Program regulations N.J.A.C. 7:36 (the regulatory process is referred to herein as a "Diversion"); and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the NJDEP Diversion process the Township of North Bergen authorized by Resolution dated August 19, 2015 support of the State House Commission Preapplication for the Diversion of the pre-k school trailer area within Braddock Park; and

WHEREAS, North Bergen owns the property located at 1814 43<sup>rd</sup> Street (Block 103, Lot 127), North Bergen, which is commonly known as North Hudson EMS South Building (herein referred to as the EMS South Building"), said property on which the building sits has been found to be subject to NJDEP jurisdiction due to receiving Green Acres funding for a prior recreational use; and

WHEREAS, although North Bergen's current use is a public use providing to a segment of the County's residents public safety services which include fire and ambulance services and emergency relief services through North Bergen C.A.R.E.S (Community Assistance Relief Events & Support), said public use is non-recreational and therefore, in violation of NJDEP regulations subjecting the property to Diversion; and

WHEREAS, since the County and North Bergen have jointly commenced the Diversion of Braddock Park, NJDEP has requested that any and all applications, hearings and regulatory compliance requirements include the EMS South Building as an additional property subject to the Diversion; and

WHEREAS, North Bergen finds there is an important public purpose in the use of the EMS South Building as set forth herein and supports the inclusion of the EMS South Building in the Diversion Application; and

WHEREAS, further since the adoption of Resolution dated August 19, 2015, the County and North Bergen, pursuant to review by NJDEP, have amended the Braddock Park area to be diverted to include, space such as parking to the Pre-K School Trailer area; and

WHEREAS, North Bergen shall amend any and all applications, documents and filings related to the NJDEP Diversion to include the additional Braddock Park area as set forth herein and the EMS South Building, and to take any other actions pursuant the rules and regulations of NJDEP in furtherance of the Diversion; and

WHEREAS, North Bergen wishes to apply for approval for the Diversion of land within Braddock Park for the continuing occupation of the North Bergen pre-k school and further supports the Diversion of the land on which the EMS South Building sits, each Diversion to be considered as a major disposal or diversion of Parkland under N.J.A.C. 7:36-26; and

WHEREAS, as required by N.J.A.C. 7:36-8, the County and North Bergen held a scoping hearing on August 11, 2020 to solicit public comment on the Diversion of parkland 1) from Braddock Park in connection with the continuing operation of the North Bergen pre-k school and 2) the EMS South Building non-recreational public safety use; and

**WHEREAS**, the next step in the application process for approval of a major disposal or diversion of parkland is the filing of a pre-application under N.J.A.C. 7:36-26.9; and

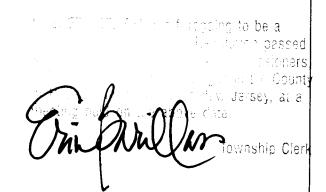

Braddock North Hudson County Park for the continuing occupation of the North Bergen Pre-K School and 2) the property located at 1814 43<sup>rd</sup> Street, North Bergen (Block 103, Lot 127) commonly known as EMS South Building pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:36-26.

Braddock North Hudson County Park for the continuing occupation of the North Bergen Pre-K School and the EMS South Building for its public safety use would meet the minimum substantive criteria at N.J.A.C. 7:36-26.1 (d) which required the following: a) fulfilling a compelling public need by mitigating a hazard to public health, safety or welfare, b) provide a significant benefit by improving the delivery of essential services to public or a segment of public with special needs and c) providing for the expanded recreation and conservation benefits and offerings far exceeding the benefits of the previous recreation facilities.
- 3. The Township of North Bergen acknowledges that in order to obtain the approval of the Diversion of land within the James J. Braddock North Hudson County Park for the continuing occupation of the North Bergen Pre-school and the EMS South Building for its public safety use, all substantive and procedural requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:36-26 must be met, including compensation requirements at N.J.A.C. 7:36-26.10.
- 4. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Mayor or Township Administrator, to execute any and all documents necessary for the purpose of performing or carrying out any studies, surveys, tests, soundings, borings, appraisals, title searches and title reports, as necessary to determine the value, boundary, ownership, interests or environmental condition of the Parcel, and as required by NJDEP regulations for the diversion of the Parcel.

#### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN'S ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY ALLOWING OUTDOOR RESTAURANT SEATING

## THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN DO ORDAIN:

#### Section 1. Background

- A. The Township of North Bergen (the "Township"), in order to help restaurants, bars and other eating and drinking establishments (hereinafter collectively "restaurants") recover from the Covid-19 pandemic shutdown, passed Ordinance No. 464-20 to temporarily allow restaurants to use outdoor seating, including on adjacent sidewalks in the Township right of way, provided certain specified requirements were met.
- B. With the Covid-19 pandemic continuing, the Township adopted Ordinance No. 475-20, which amended Ordinance 464-20 by:
  - 1. Extending the date through which outdoor dining is permissible;
  - 2. Instituting certain controls as to noise and music being played or heard outdoors;
  - 3. Recognizing the Township's program of temporary street closures to allow for expanded outdoor dining; and
  - 4. Extending the fee waiver applicable to the Township's "outdoor cafés" Ordinance No. 331-17.
- C. With the Covid-19 pandemic still continuing, the Township recognizes the need to further amend Ordinance No. 464-20, as set forth below in Section 2.
- D. The Township Board of Commissioners finds that this Ordinance should take effect immediately upon final adoption, and that the 20-day waiting period pursuant N.J.S.A. 40:74-4 should not apply because this Ordinance's immediate enactment is necessary for the welfare of Township businesses due to the hardship arising out of the Covid-19 pandemic.

#### Section 2. Amendments

#### A. Outdoor Café Fee Waiver Extended

Ordinance No. 464-20 is further amended to replace Section 2, subparagraph A, "Waiver of Fees" with the following language:

The \$250 fee for any "outdoor cafés" or "seasonal enclosures" under Ordinance 331-17, is hereby waived and not required for applications until such time as the Township determines to discontinue Outdoor Restaurant Seating otherwise authorized by Ordinance No. 464-20.

#### B. Extension of Outdoor Restaurant Seating

Ordinance No. 464-20 is further amended to replace Section 6 "Termination of Outdoor Seating" with the following language:

- A. Outdoor seating permission, licenses and permits granted under this Ordinance are (i) revocable at will or (ii) revocable based on the conclusion of the current Covid-19 state of emergency.
- B. Subject to any earlier termination set forth under Section 6.A., the outdoor restaurant seating program established by Ordinance 464-20, as amended, shall continue until terminated by future Ordinance.

#### C. Regulations for Heaters

- 1. The Rules and Regulations controlling heaters for Outdoor Restaurant Seating previously distributed by the Township to restaurants in or about September 2020, are incorporated into this Ordinance by reference as if fully set forth herein at length.
- 2. Any restaurant violating the heater regulations, or violating any fire or building code regulations, is subject to revocation of its outdoor seating permit, as well as any other penalties available under the Uniform Fire Code and Uniform Building Code.

#### D. <u>Heaters, Tents, Awnings, and Umbrellas</u>

Any restaurant using propane or electric heaters or tents, awnings, umbrellas, and/or any other apparatus used to block sunlight, wind, or to otherwise shield patrons from the weather elements, during Outdoor Restaurant Seating must immediately remove such items in the event of inclement weather, including, but not limited to, snow, high winds, tropical storms, tornadoes, and hurricanes. The Township reserves the right to (1) require restaurants to remove such items at the Township's sole and absolute discretion, and (2) revoke a restaurant's outdoor seating permit and ability to participate in street closure events if any restaurant that fails to comply with this provision.

#### Section 3. Penalties

The penalty and violation provisions set forth in Ordinance No. 464-20 are also applicable for any violations of this Ordinance.

#### Section 4. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

#### Section 5. <u>Liberal Construction & Delegation of Authority</u>

- A. This Ordinance, being necessary for the welfare of the Township businesses, shall be liberally construed to effectuate its purposes.
- B. For any unique circumstances presented for particular restaurants, street closures, or weather conditions, the Township Administrator, in consultation with the Director of Community Improvement, Police Chief, and Zoning Officer, shall have the discretion to require any additional requirements and conditions.
- C. The Mayor, Township Administrator, Chief Financial Officer, Treasurer, Township Attorney, Township Engineer, Director of Community Improvement, Police Chief, Zoning Officer, Township Clerk, Township Purchasing Agent and any other necessary official, officer or employee of the Township be and

they are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and to take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Ordinance.

#### Section 6. Severability

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

#### Section 7. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption.

## AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF LOADING ZONES ON BROADWAY AVENUE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN

# THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN DO ORDAIN:

#### Section 1. Background

The Township of North Bergen has previously converted certain parking along Broadway Avenue to angled parking. This converted parking pattern has created the need for loading zones in certain locations on Broadway Avenue.

#### Section 2. <u>Loading Zones Established</u>

- A. Loading zones, which shall be in effect from 6:00 am to 12:00 midnight, seven days per week, are hereby established in the following locations:
  - 1. On the western side of Broadway Avenue, beginning 13.5 feet north of the intersection of 77<sup>th</sup> Street and Broadway Avenue, and continuing to run north, said loading zone being 39.5 feet in length.
  - 2. On the western side of Broadway Avenue, beginning 19.5 feet south of the intersection of 75<sup>th</sup> Street and Broadway Avenue, and continuing to run south, said loading zone being 40.5 feet in length.
- B. The Township Department of Public Works, North Bergen Parking Authority, and Township Police Department, Traffic Division, together with any other Township officer, employee or agent, be and they are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and to take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Ordinance, including, but not limited to the following:
  - 1. Preparation of all necessary traffic engineering plans & diagrams;
  - 2. Determining the exact location and dimensions of the loading zones, given the location of meters, utilities, crosswalks, fire hydrants, and other characteristics of the area;
  - 3. Installing all necessary markings, painted lines and signage;
  - 4. Modifying the effective days and times of the loading zones if the need arises.

#### Section 3. Enforcement

The Parking Authority of the Township of North Bergen shall have and exercise the power and perform the duties associated with the management, operation and enforcement of this Ordinance. The North Bergen Police Department shall also enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

#### **Section 4: Penalty**

Owners and Lessees of vehicles parked in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$75.00 per offense.

#### Section 5. **Fine Share**

The Parking Authority shall receive from the Township 40% of each summons written by parking enforcement officers, where the fine is collected by the Township for violation of this Ordinance.

#### Section 6. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed.

#### Section 7. **Severability**

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

#### Section 8. **Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days from the time of its final passage.

### THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN DO ORDAIN:

#### Section 1: Background

On November 26, 2019, the Township of North Bergen adopted "A Superseding Ordinance Providing for the Establishment and Regulation of Loading Zones within the Township of North Bergen," designated as Ordinance #438-19. That Ordinance provides that businesses may apply to the Township of North Bergen Parking Authority to establish loading zones in front of or in the vicinity of their businesses. The Township has received two (2) Resolutions adopted by the Parking Authority recommending that certain loading zones be established. The Township wishes to formally implement the Parking Authority's recommendations and establish by ordinance the recommended loading zones.

#### Section 2: Loading Zones Established

A. Loading zones at the following locations, having the following dimensions, and being in effect for the following times, are hereby established.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen recognize that handicapped drivers face unique difficulties in the location of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen have been empowered by

N.J.S.A. 39:4-205 to restrict certain areas for handicapped parking; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 503-93, Ordinance No. 1115-07, Ordinance No. 40-10 and Ordinance No. 203-13 establish the terms and conditions for handicapped spaces.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen that:

**Section 1:** One restricted handicapped parking space be and hereby is established in front of the residence of **Erica Ravelo** of **1212** 73<sup>rd</sup> **Street**, North Bergen, N.J. 07047.

**Section 2:** The aforesaid space shall be used only by a motor vehicle displaying a permit issued by the North Bergen Police Department identifying the location of said handicapped parking space and the specific motor vehicle entitled to use same.

Section 3: The North Bergen Department of Public Works shall establish a restricted parking zone at the above location and shall erect a sign with the legend "Handicapped Parking for Resident Vehicle License Plate Number "S 4 3 L S G" for Erica Ravelo and this Ordinance Number.

**Section 4**: This ordinance shall remain in effect for two (2) years ending December 31<sup>st</sup> of the second year from its effective date at which point it will expire and be of no further force or effect unless it is renewed for a further two (2) year period by formal resolution of the Board of Commissioners in accordance with Ordinance Nos. 1115-07 and 40-10.

**Section 5:** Any person who commits a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of at least \$300.00 and up to 90 days of Community Service on such terms and in such form as the Municipal Court Judge deems appropriate or any combination thereof. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which the violation continues.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistency thereof.

**Section 7**: If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

**Section 8**: This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.
