

WHEREAS, it appears by said application that the encroachment may result in difficulties in the sale or refunding of said building; and

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen, has never objected to the existence of said encroachment and that said encroachment will not result in any inconvenience to the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Commissioners, of the Township of North Bergen, in the County of Hudson,

Section 1. Permission is hereby granted to the Rosotti Lithographing Co., Inc., to maintain an encroachment over the northerly line of Eighty-fifth Street as follows:

Beginning at a point in the northerly line of 85th Street where the same is intersected by the easterly face of a certain one story brick vault and which said point is distant one hundred sixty-three and twenty-seven hundredths (163.27) feet westerly of the intersection formed by the westerly line of Tonnelle Avenue produced southerly with the northerly line of 85th Street - produced easterly and running thence (1) North forty - two degrees seven minutes twenty-six seconds West (N 42°07'26"W) along the northerly line of 85th Street and thru the aforesaid vault nineteen and twenty-seven hundredths (19.27) feet to the westerly face of said vault, thence, (2) South forty - seven degrees fifty-two minutes thirty-four seconds West (S 47°02'34"W) and along the aforesaid westerly face of vault seventy-three hundredths (0.73) feet to the southerly face thereof, thence, (3) South forty-one degrees fifty-eight minutes forty-six seconds East (S 41°08'46"E) and along the southerly face of the aforesaid vault nineteen and twenty-seven hundredths (19.27) feet to the easterly face thereof, thence (4) North forty-seven degrees fifty-two minutes thirty-four seconds East (N 47°02'34"E) and along the easterly face of the aforesaid vault seventy-eight hundredths (0.78) feet to the northerly line of 85th Street and the point or place of beginning.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING LICENSES AND TO
LICENSE CERTAIN KINDS OF BUSINESS AND OCCUPATIONS, AND TO FIX THE AMOUNT OF LICENSE FEES TO BE PAID."

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen, in the County of Hudson,

do ordain:
1. Section 7 of the ordinance of which this ordinance is amendatory is hereby amended by

adding thereto a sub-section, which shall be designated as 'Sub-section B', which shall read as follows:
Sub-section B: The following enumerated purposes, except those excepted by Section 2 of a

certain ordinance entitled

"An ordinance to regulate and license boarding houses,
rooming houses, lodging houses, hotels, apartment hotels
and to safeguard the occupants thereof and providing
penalties for violations thereof," introduced November
19, 1947.

are hereby required to be licensed and the license fees therefor shall be as follows:

Boarding House (per room).....	\$1.00 per year
Rooming House (per room).....	\$1.00 per year
Lodging House (per room).....	\$1.00 per year
Hotel (less than 50 rooms).....	\$50.00 per year
Hotel (50 rooms or more).....	\$100.00 per year
Apartment Hotel (less than 50 rooms).....	\$50.00 per year
Apartment Hotel (50 rooms or more).....	\$100.00 per year

2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication as required by law.
