

Section 1: That section 5.01 of the ordinance entitled as above be amended so as to read as follows:

5.01 THROUGH STREETS: The streets described in the following schedule are hereby declared to be through streets:

Park Avenue
Broadway
Bergenline Avenue
46th Street

Section 2: That section 5.04 of said ordinance be deleted and in place thereof a new section 5.04 substituted, reading as follows:

5.04: DESCRIPTION OF BUS STOPS: That the bus stops referred to in the preceding section shall terminate 70 feet from the corner and be appropriately marked, and no other vehicles shall park within the said bus stop locations.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect after approval by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and its adoption and publication as required by law.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of
North Bergen in the County of Hudson do ordain:

Section 1: That the said ordinance entitled
as above be amended and supplemented by adding thereto a
section to be known as section 7a and providing as
follows:

Section 7a: The hours of employment of the
uniformed members of the Police Department of this Town-
ship shall not exceed eight consecutive hours in any
one day nor forty hours in any one week; provided that
in the case of an emergency, the Director of the Depart-
ment of Public Safety, or any other officer authorized
to act in his place and stead, shall have full authority
to summon and keep on duty any and all such members of
such department during the period of emergency.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect
upon adoption and publication as required by law.

as the "Law against Discrimination", approved April 16, 1945, and the severe amendments and supplements thereto and constituting Chapter 25, of Title 18 of the Revised Statutes.

Section 2. The said commission shall be known as the Civil Rights Commission of the Township of North Bergen and shall consist of five (5) representative citizens, no residents of said township and citizens of the United States, serving without compensation, to be appointed by the Mayor and whose terms of office shall be co-terminous with that of said Mayor or such short time as shall be fixed by him.

Section 3. Said commission shall foster through community effort or otherwise, good will, cooperation and conciliation among the groups and elements of the inhabitants of the community and may make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners of said township for the development of policies and procedures in general and for programs of formal and informal education that will aid in eliminating all types of discrimination based upon race, creed, color, national origin and ancestry.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication according to law.

WHEREAS, heretofore on March 1, 1950, the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson adopted a budget for the current year 1950 and as a part of said budget there was included under "Capital Improvements" a line item reading as follows:

"Capital Improvement Fund \$30,000.00

and
WHEREAS, at the time of such adoption it was intended that a part of the money so appropriated for capital improvements should include the purchase of a fire engine pump for the use of the Department of Public Safety of the Township of North Bergen, and

WHEREAS, the Township of North Bergen has received bids in connection with the purchase of such fire engine pump and it is desirable to make available monies in order that a contract for the purchase of the same may be entered into,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson do ordain:

Section 1: That the sum of \$17,500.00 is hereby appropriated out of the capital improvement fund heretofore authorized by the budget of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson adopted on March 1, 1950, pursuant to the line item heretofore referred to.

Section 2: That the said appropriation of the monies out of said capital improvement fund shall be used not to constitute a new debt of the Township of North Bergen but solely for the purpose of financing the purchase of said fire engine pump and for the capital improvement fund heretofore referred to.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
