Section 5. The provisions of Section 3 shall not apply to the renewal of licenses which are issued and outstanding on the passage of this Ordinance, nor shall said provisions apply to the transfer of such licenses from person to person, nor to the renewal of licenses so transferred.

Section 6. No plenary retail consumption licenses excepting renewals shall be issued for or transferred to any premises within 750 feet of any other premises for which a Plenary Retail Consumption License shall then be outstanding, provided, however, that such licenses may be transferred to any premises located within 750 feet of the premises for which such license was outstanding at the time of the adoption of this Ordinance. The distance shall be measured from the nearest entrance of the nearest licensed premises to the nearest entrance of the premises sought to be licensed, in the normal way that a pedestrian would properly walk and in accordance with the procedure established pursuant to R.S. 33:1-76. Nothing in this section shall apply to Club Licenses or to Plenary Consumption Licenses or to Plenary Consumption Licenses held by Clubs which qualify under the State Laws and Regulations for a Club License which are now issued and outstanding or any renewals thereof.

Section 7. No Plenary Retail Distribution Licenses, excepting renewals, shall be issued for or transferred to any premises within 750 feet of any other premises for which a Plenary Retail Distribution License shall then be outstanding, provided, however, that such licenses may be transferred to any premises located within 750 feet of the premises for which

shall prevent the holders of Club Licenses which are now issued and outstanding or any renewals thereof from securing any retail consumption licenses in place thereof, not with-

standing the numerical limitations, provided, however, that any plenary retail consumption license issued pursuant to this provision shall be conditioned that it shall continue to be held by a Club which can qualify under the State Law and Regulations for a Club License, for violation of which the license shall be subject to suspension or revocation.

Section 9. No licensee shall sell, serve, deliver or allow, permit or suffer the sale, service or delivery of any alcoholic beverage, or allow the consumption of any alcoholic beverage on licensed premises, on New Year's Day when it is a weekday between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M., on

New Year's Day when it is a Sunday between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and noon, on other weekdays between the hours of 3:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M., on other Sundays between the hours of 4:00 A.M. and noon.

During the hours sales of alcoholic beverages are prohibited, there shall be a clear view of the bar or bars in the licensed premises, from the public thoroughfare of

from an adjacent room to which the public is freely admitted. The hours above referred to shall be Eastern Standard Time, except from 2:00 A.M., on the last Sunday in April until 2:00 A.M. on the last Sunday in September of

each year, when they shall be Eastern Daylight Saving Time, which time is one hour in advance of Eastern Standard Time.
