AN OPDINANCE CHEATING THE OFFICE OF MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON, PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES, FIXING THE TERM AND THE SALARY THEREOF.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson, do ordain:

Section 1. There is hereby created the office of Municipal Prosecutor of the Township of North Bergen.

Section 2. The Municipal Prosecutor, who shall be an Attorney at Law, shall prosecute all cases to be tried before the Municipal Magistrate, (or such acting Magistrate as may then and there be sitting or acting in his pla place and stood), and shall assume and perform any and all other duties as may from time to time be assigned to the office of Municipal Prosecutor, by statute, or Municipal Ordinance, charter, or by Police power, rule or regulation originally chartered, adopted or promulgated by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen.

Section 3. The term of office of said Municipal Prosecutor shall be fo three (3) years and until the appointment and qualification of his successor

Section 4. The salary of the Municipal Prosecutor shall be the sum of \$3,000.00 annually, payable in semi-monthly installments.

Section 5. The executive, administrative, judicial and legislative powers and (uties relating to the Office of Municipal Prosecutor, as aforesaid, shall be assigned to and distributed in such department as may be determined by the Board of Commissioners.

Section 6. All ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with th

provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING A PORTION OF LANDS COMMONLY KNOWN AS BLOCK 244, FLOT 2A NOW OWNED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON, FOR USE AS A PUBLIC STREET.
