AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF
MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF
HUDSON, PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES, FIXING
THE TERM AND THE SALARY THEREOF.

* * * * *

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson, do ordain:

Section 1. There is hereby created the office of Municipal Prosecutor of the Township of North Bergen.

Section 2. The Municipal Prosecutor, who shall be an Attorney at Law, shall prosecute all cases to be tried before the Municipal Magistrate, (or such acting Magistrate as may then and there be sitting or acting in his place and stead), and shall assume and perform any and all other duties as may from time to time be assigned to the office of Municipal Prosecutor, by statute, or Municipal Ordinance, charter, or by Police power, rule or regulation originally chartered, adopted or promulgated by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen.

Section 3. The term of office of said Municipal Prosecutor shall be for three (3) years and until the appointment and qualification of his successor.

Section 4. The salary of the Municipal Prosecutor shall be the sum of \$3,000.00 annually, payable in semi-monthly installments.

Section 5. The executive, administrative, judicial and legislative powers and duties relating to the Office of Municipal Prosecutor, as aforesaid, shall be assigned to and distributed in such department as may be determined by the Board of Commissioners.

Section 6. All ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect after the adoption and publication thereof as required by law.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen
County of Hudson, DO ORDAIN:

Section 1: That a portion of lands commonly known as Block
244, Plot 2A now owned by the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson,
be and the same is hereby dedicated by said Township for use as
a public street, as an extension of the present Newkirk Avenue from its
present northerly terminus as laid out on the amended map of Rock Cellar
Park, and running approximately two hundred fourteen (214) feet to the
southerly side of 72nd Street as laid out on said map, and having a
width of forty (40) feet throughout from said present northerly terminus
of Newkirk Avenue to the said southerly side of 72nd street.

Section 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances be and
the same are hereby repealed as to the conflicting portions thereof.

Section 3: That this ordinance take effect immediately after
adoption and publication thereof as required by law.
