described as follows: Beginning at a point  
in the southerly line of 72nd Street where  
the same is intersected by the center line of  
Madison Street as shown on the Tax Map of the  
Township of North Bergen dated October 1, 1954,  
and from said point of beginning going thence,  
(1) easterly and along the said southerly line  
of 72nd Street a distance of 25 feet, more or  
less to a point in the proposed easterly line  
of Madison Street as shown on the said Tax Map;  
thence, (2) southerly and along the easterly line  
of said proposed Madison Street a distance of  
89.92 feet more or less, to southerly line of  
Plot 21 thence, (3) westerly and along the said  
southerly line of said Plot 21 a distance of  
25 feet to the center line of said Madison Street

DECEMBER 4, 1940.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen  
in the County of Hudson, New Jersey, DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of Section 6 of an ordinance en-  
titled as above is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

No Plenary Retail Consumption licenses, except renewals,  
shall be issued for or transferred to any premises within 750 feet  
of any other premises for which a Plenary Retail Consumption license  
shall then be outstanding, provided however, that such licenses may  
be transferred to any premises located within 750 feet of the premises  
for which such license was outstanding at the time of the adoption of  
this ordinance, but this shall not include the right to transfer such  
license to any premises located within 200 feet of a firehouse. The  
distance shall be measured from the nearest entrance of the nearest  
licensed premises to the nearest entrance of the premises sought to  
be licensed, in the normal way that a pedestrian would properly walk  
and in accordance with the procedure established pursuant to R.S.33:1-76.  
Nothing in this section shall apply to club licenses or to plenary  
consumption licenses held by clubs which qualify under the state laws  
and Regulations for a club license and which are now issued and out-  
standing or any renewal thereof.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent  
with this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby  
repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect when adopted and  
published as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson DO ORDAIN:

Section 1: That Stanton Street from Cottage Avenue to Meadowview Avenue, be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED  
"AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE SALE AT RETAIL  
OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF  
NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON", ADOPTED  
DECEMBER 4, 1940.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson,  
New Jersey, DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of Section 6 of an ordinance entitled as above is hereby  
amended so as to read as follows:

No Plenary Retail Consumption Licenses, except renewals, shall be issued for or  
transferred to any premises within 750 feet of any other premises for which a Plenary Retail  
Consumption License shall then be outstanding, provided, however, that such licenses may be  
transferred to any premises located within 750 feet of the premises for which such license  
was outstanding at the time of the adoption of this ordinance, but this shall not include the  
right to transfer such license to any premises located within 200 feet of a firehouse; provided,  
however, that this provision shall not prevent the transfer of such license to premises within  
200 feet of a firehouse if same is operated as a restaurant, as defined in R.S. 33:1-1 (t); and  
provided, further, that in any restaurant within this exception, there shall be no bar, except  
a service bar, or service bars, nor any bar opened to the public, nor sale of intoxicating  
beverages for off premises consumption. The distance shall be measured from the nearest entrance  
of the nearest licensed premises to the nearest entrance of the premises sought to be licensed,  
in the normal way that a pedestrian would properly walk and in accordance with the procedure  
established pursuant to R.S. 33:1-76. Nothing in this section shall apply to club licenses or  
to plenary consumption licenses held by clubs which qualify under the state Laws and Regulations  
for a club license and which are now issued and outstanding or any renewal thereof.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are,  
to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.



Recital

Pursuant to due action of the Board of Education of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson, New Jersey, taken at and pursuant to its meeting duly held on June 4th, 1963, and due action of the Board of School Estimate of the Township, taken at and pursuant to its meeting duly held on June 4th, 1963, the sum of \$220,000.00 has been estimated, fixed and determined as the additional amount of money necessary for the school improvement or purpose described in Section 1 of the ordinance set forth below, all as more fully appears by the certificate heretofore made by said Board of School Estimate and delivered to this Board of Commissioners. No part of said amount has been appropriated by this Board of Commissioners and no part of said amount has been raised and paid to the Custodian of School Moneys.

ORDINANCE

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON, NEW JERSEY, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Title 18 of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey, particularly Article 6 of Chapter 6 of said Title and any other laws applicable thereto, there is hereby appropriated for the school improvement or purpose hereinbelow described, in addition to monies heretofore appropriated therefor, the sum of money hereinbelow stated:

Acquisition of lands by gift, grant, purchase or condemnation, for use for school purposes, located in the Township on the southwesterly corner of Hudson Boulevard and 76th Street and designated as Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7A, 7B, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 in Block 263 and Lot 13 in Block 324, as shown on the Tax Map of said Township, the construction on said land of a new high school and an administration building, the furnishing and equipping of said high school and administration building and the improvement of the sites thereof

\$ 220,000.00

Section 3. This Board of Commissioners being the governing body of the Township, hereby concurs in and consents to the said appropriation.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC  
AFFAIRS COMMITTEE IN THE DEPARTMENT  
OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF  
NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen  
in the County of Hudson do ordain:

Section 1. There is hereby established in the Township of  
North Bergen a Public Affairs Committee in the Department of Public  
Affairs, consisting of five representative citizens, residents of  
the Township and citizens of the United States, who shall be appointed  
by the Director of the Department of Public Affairs together with a  
secretary to said committee, each to serve for a term of one year,  
at an annual salary of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars each.

Section 2. The said Committee shall foster the observance  
of all events, local, state and national, which shall bring to the  
citizens of the community the recollection of their historic past,  
including the 1964 Tercentenary; shall encourage the development  
of the community spirit by encouraging collective physical activi-  
ties in gymnasiums and schoolyards and shall foster pride in the ap-  
pearance of the Township by securing appropriate lighting through-  
out the same and shall, in addition thereto, enforce animal regula-  
tions and insure proper trash removal.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING COMMUNITY FACILITIES  
BOARD IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN IN  
THE COUNTY OF HUDSON.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen  
in the County of Hudson do ordain:

Section 1. A local board is hereby created in the Township  
of North Bergen in the County of Hudson to be known as the Community  
Facilities Board which shall consist of five representative citizens,  
residents of the Township and citizens of the United States, who  
shall be appointed by the Mayor to serve for one year at an annual  
compensation of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars each for their services.  
Such Board shall likewise be entitled to the services of a secretary  
at an annual compensation of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars a year.

Section 2. The said Board shall promote the community effort  
in promoting educational recreation, hobby interests for young people  
and, when required, assist in giving advice in connection with juvenile  
delinquency and otherwise foster the development of youth and their  
proper orientation in the Township of North Bergen.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately  
upon its final passage and publication according to law.

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET  
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON  
AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY SHOWN AND DESIGNATED ON THE  
TAX MAP OF NORTH BERGEN AS, LIBERTY AVENUE AND FORMERLY  
KNOWN AS 4TH STREET OR PEERLESS PLACE.

WHEREAS this Board did by an ordinance adopted September 1, 1937, grant the United States Rubber Products Company or its assigns permission to maintain an encroachment over the property line of Lot 4 Block 174 of a certain two story brick building of 0.47 feet over the northerly line of said lot of 0.47 feet of the westerly corner of said building and gradually decreasing to 0.00 feet at the easterly corner of said building, and on and over the westerly lot line of 4.95 feet at the northerly corner of said building and gradually increasing to 5.09 feet at a point in the westerly portion of the building 8 feet northerly of the southerly terminus of Peerless Place, approximately 8 feet by 18.84 feet; and

WHEREAS the owner of said property find that the adoption of the above prescribed ordinance has not resulted in granting them relief in title insurance, financing, mortgage or sale of the premises; and

WHEREAS Liberty Avenue from 51st Street, southerly for a distance of 100 feet is unpaved and is used only to provide access to three abutting owners who enjoy the use of only the westerly 27.58 feet of the unoccupied width of said Liberty Avenue; and

WHEREAS the owners of the property located on Plot 4, Block 174 have petitioned this Board for the vacation of that portion of Liberty Avenue occupied by the encroaching portion of said building; and

WHEREAS this Board deems that the vacation of the easterly 5.09 feet of Liberty Avenue will give the owners of said property relief without hardship to the public, now, therefore,

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson do ordain:

Section 1. That the portion of Liberty Avenue described as follows: "Beginning at a point in the southerly line of 51st Street where the same is intersected by the easterly line of Liberty Avenue and going thence (1) southerly and along said easterly line of Liberty Avenue 100 feet to a point in the southerly terminus of said Liberty Avenue; thence (2) westerly and along said southerly terminus of Liberty Avenue 5.09 feet to a point; thence (3) northerly and parallel or nearly so to the easterly line of Liberty Avenue 100 feet to a point in the southerly line of 51st Street; thence (4) easterly and along said southerly line of 51st Street 4.95 feet to the point and place of beginning", be and the same hereby is vacated as not required for the use of the public as a street or highway.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance or any part hereof are hereby repealed as to the same.

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET,  
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, COUNTY OF HUDSON,  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY SHOWN AND DESIGNATED ON THE TAX  
MAP OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN AS 67TH STREET  
FROM THE WESTERLY LINE OF MEADOWVIEW AVENUE TO A  
POINT 37.40 WESTERLY THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township  
of North Bergen in the County of Hudson and State of New Jersey as  
follows:

Section 1. That the portion of 67th Street described as  
follows and not heretofore used for public purposes to wit:

"Beginning at a point formed by the intersection of the westerly  
line of Meadowview Avenue (formerly Liberty Street) with the northerly  
line of 67th Street (formerly known as 23rd Street) going thence; (1)  
Westerly along the said Northerly line of 67th Street, a distance of

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson do ordain:

Section 1. That Paragraph 3 of Section 1 of an ordinance entitled as above, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

The term "at all such times" as used in this section, unless otherwise provided by a contract or agreement, shall include the time between the hours of 6 A.M. and 11 P.M. in a building or portion thereof occupied as a home or place of residence and during the usual working hours established and maintained in a building or portion thereof occupied as a business establishment. Heat is to be furnished when outside temperature is fifty-five degrees or below at all other times, except between June 10th and September 10th in any year.

Recital

Pursuant to due action of the Board of Education of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson, New Jersey, taken at and pursuant to its meeting duly held on November 14, 1963, and due action of the Board of School Estimate of the Township, taken at and pursuant to its meeting duly held November 14, 1963, the sum of \$1,650,000.00 has been estimated, fixed and determined as the amount of money necessary for the school improvement or purpose described in Section 1 of the ordinance set forth below, all as more fully appears by the certificate heretofore made by said Board of School Estimate and delivered to this Board of Commissioners. No part of said amount has been appropriated by this Board of Commissioners and no part of said amount has been raised and paid to the Custodian of School Moneys.

Ordinance

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON, NEW JERSEY, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Title 18 of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey, particularly Article 8 of Chapter 6 of said Title and any other laws applicable thereto, there is hereby appropriated for the school improvement or purpose hereinbelow described the sum of money hereinbelow stated:

School Improvement or Purpose

Amount

Acquisition of lands by gift, grant, purchase or condemnation, located in the Township between 11th and 12th Streets and designated as Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 17, 18, 19, 55, 56, 57, 58 and 59 in Block 22, as shown on the Tax Map of said Township, and the construction on said lands of a new schoolhouse, the furnishing and equip-

Township previously adopted and hereby appropriated for said improvement or purpose, and the remaining \$1,625,000.00 of said sum so appropriated shall be borrowed and shall be met from the proceeds of sale of bonds of the Township, which are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the statutory provisions referred to in Section 1 hereof, in the principal amount of \$1,625,000.00.

Section 3. Each of said bonds shall be designated "School Bond" and shall be coupon bonds registerable as to principal only or as to both principal and interest, and shall be in such form and of such denomination, shall bear such date, shall mature in such years and amounts and shall bear interest at such rate, not exceeding six per centum (6%) per annum as shall hereafter be determined by resolution.

Section 4. This Board of Commissioners being the governing body of the Township, hereby concurs in and consents to the said appropriation and in and to the issuance of said bonds.

Section 5. It is hereby determined that the period within which said bonds shall mature, being the period assigned by Section 18:6-66 of said Revised Statutes to the purpose for which said bonds are to be issued, is forty (40) years.

Section 6. The authorization of the \$1,625,000.00 bonds provided for by this ordinance uses up none of the borrowing margin of the Township previously available for other improvements.

Section 7. The full faith and credit of the Township are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds. Said bonds shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Township, and the Township shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Township for the payment of said bonds and interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect at the expiration of ten days from the date of its publication after final passage as provided by law.
