

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON TONNELE AVENUE (STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE NO. 1)
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson,
do ordain:

SECTION 1: The parking of any vehicle at any and all times and points on
Tonnele Avenue (State Highway Route No. 1) within the limits of the Township of North Bergen in
the County of Hudson is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2: The word "parking" used in this ordinance shall mean the standing or
waiting on any street, road or highway of any vehicle not actually engaged in the discharging
and receiving of passengers or merchandise unless in obedience to traffic regulations or
traffic signs or signals. The word "vehicle" shall mean every device in, upon or by which
a person or property is or may be transported on the highway.


SECTION 3: Any person or persons, company, partnership, or corporation
violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to a penalty of not more than
Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days, or both,
as in the discretion of the magistrate he may impose.


SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be effective upon approval by the Commissioner
of Motor Vehicles and its adoption and publication as required by law.





AN ORDINANCE FOR THE VACATION OF PARK PLACE
AND RUTH PLACE BETWEEN BURR AVENUE (NOW KNOWN
AS 74th STREET) AND 31st STREET (NOW KNOWN AS
75th STREET), IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN,
IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON, NEW JERSEY.

WHEREAS, a certain map entitled "Map of property
of Winfield S. Danielson, in County Block #2513, North Bergen,
Hudson County, New Jersey, prepared on June 29th, 1921 by
Richard A. Beyer and A. J. Mahnken, Civil Engineers, Hoboken,
N. J., "not filed in the Office of the Register of the County
of Hudson, has been in use for the conveyance of real estate,
and

WHEREAS, certain streets designated as Park Place
and Ruth Place are shown on said map and have also been shown
on certain copies of the Tax Map of the Township of North
Bergen, and

WHEREAS, said Park Place and Ruth Place have
never been used as public streets by the public, nor are now
required for such use,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of
Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen, in the County
of Hudson, as follows:

Section 1. That the strips of land shown on a
map entitled "Map of property of Winfield S. Danielson, in
County Block #2513, North Bergen, Hudson County, New Jersey,
prepared on June 29th, 1921 by Richard A. Beyer and A. J.
Mahnken, Civil Engineers, Hoboken, N. J., designated as Park
Place and Ruth Place and lying between the northerly line
of Burr Avenue (now known as 74th Street) and the southerly
line of 31st Street (now known as 75th Street), as shown on
said map, be and the same are hereby vacated.

in the Commercial and Light Industrial District.

2. The Township Engineer be hereby directed to amend the
"Use District Map" to conform to the changes hereinabove set forth.

3. This ordinance shall take effect when adopted and pub-
lished as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF BERGENWOOD AVENUE
FORMERLY KNOWN AS RIDGELY STREET, ON A MAP OF ROCK CELLAR
PARK, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN, COUNTY OF HUDSON,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY:

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North
Bergen, in the County of Hudson, DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. That portion of Bergenwood Avenue, formerly
known as Ridgely Street, which is described as follows:

ALL that certain tract or parcel of land and premises, sit-
uate in the township of North Bergen, County of Hudson and
State of New Jersey BEGINNING at a point in the westerly
line of Bergenwood Avenue, formerly known as Ridgely Street,
distant one hundred (100') feet northerly of 70th Street,
formerly 25th Street, and continuing from said point going
thence (1) northerly along said westerly line of Bergenwood
Avenue (64.17') sixty-four and seventeen one-hundredths feet
to the northwesterly corner of said Street; thence (2)
easterly along the northerly terminus of said Street thirty
(30') feet to a point in the northeasterly line of said Street
thence (3) southerly along the easterly line of said Street
sixty-four and sixty-two one-hundredths (64.62') feet to
a point; thence (4) in a westerly direction thirty (30')
feet to the point and place of beginning.

BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY VACATED.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect when
adopted and published as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE FLOREL PARK INC, ITS SUCCESSORS AND
ASSIGNS THE RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN AN UNDER AND
OVER LINES UNDER AND ABOVE 35TH STREET IN THE TOWNSHIP OF
NORTH BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the
County of Hudson, do ordain:

Section 1: Permission is hereby granted to the Florel Park Inc,
its successors and assigns the right to construct and maintain steam
heating lines, hot water lines and other utility service lines under
and above 35th Street, between Hudson Boulevard and Grand Avenue for
supplying services between the Northerly and Southerly Heating units
to be constructed by Florel Park Inc., its successors and assigns for
the life of the said heating development.

Section 2: That all work in making of street openings and re-
placement of pavement be done at the cost of Florel Park Inc., in accord-
ance with standard specifications of the Township of North Bergen and
at points approved by the Township Engineer.

Section 3: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the conflicting portions
thereof and that this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and
publication as required by law.

District Map" as being in the Business Zone or District and
Lots 22, 23 and Lots 24 to 28, inclusive in Block 242B, shown
and designated on the said "Use District Map" as being in the
Second Residential Zone or District and that portion of
Bergenwood Avenue 100 feet North of 70th Street heretofore
vacated for use as a public street shall hereafter be laid
down and shown on said Map as being in the Commercial and
Light Industrial Zone or District.

2. The Township Engineer be hereby directed to amend the
"Use District Map" to conform to the changes hereinabove set
forth.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect when adopted and
published as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BERGEN
IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen in the County of
Hudson do ordain:

Section 1: A municipal court to be named the "Municipal Court of the Township
of North Bergen in the County of Hudson" is hereby established in said Township pursuant to
the provisions of Chapter 8A of Title 2 of the Revised Statutes.

Section 2: The Recorder of the Township of North Bergen in the County of Hudson
who shall have been in office on September 15, 1948, be and he is hereby appointed Magistrate
of said Court for a term equal to the balance of his then existing term, and he shall have,
possess, and exercise all the functions, powers, duties and jurisdiction as is conferred upon
such magistrate by the provisions of R. S. 2:8A, or by any other law.

Section 3: The said Magistrate shall be compensated by an annual salary which
is hereby fixed at \$3,000. a year which shall be paid as and when other salaries are paid.

Section 4: The person holding the office of Clerk, Recorder's Court, is hereby
transferred to the Municipal Court herein established, and he shall continue to exercise
his functions and perform his duties as Clerk for such Municipal Court.

Section 5: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are
hereby repealed.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect when adopted and published as re-
quired by law.







The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North Bergen, in the County of Hudson, DO ORDAIN:

1. That Paragraph 1 of Section VIII of an ordinance entitled as above be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "All apartment houses hereafter built on Boulevard East, shall be constructed at least seven feet from the front line, provided that where an apartment now fronts on any street in the block, the proposed new apartment may be built to the line as established by the front line of the nearest existing apartment".
 2. That Section IX, Paragraph 1 is hereby repealed.
 3. That the Township Engineer be and he is hereby directed to amend the Use District Map and re-number applicable sections and paragraph to conform to the changes hereinabove set forth.
 4. This ordinance shall take effect when adopted and published as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED
"AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES TO BE PAID TO THE OFFICERS
AND MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH
BERGEN IN THE COUNTY OF HUDSON, NEW JERSEY," ADOPTED JULY
22ND, 1944.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of North
Bergen in the County of Hudson do ordain:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of an ordinance entitled as
above be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as
follows:

SECTION 1. That on and after January 1st, 1945, the
salaries to be paid to the officers and firemen of the Fire
Department of the Township of North Bergen, in the County of
Hudson, shall be as follows:

For the office of Chief, the sum of \$4,500.00 per annum.
For the office of Deputy Chief, the sum of \$4,000.00
per annum.

For the office of Superintendent of Fire Alarm and
Police Signal System, the sum of \$4,000.00 per annum.
For the office of Captain, the sum of \$3,000.00 per annum.
For the office of Lieutenant, the sum of \$2,500.00 per annum.
For the office of Mechanic, the sum of \$2,500.00 per annum.
For the office of Alarm Operator, the sum of \$2,000.00
per annum.

For the office of Fireman:

For the first six months of service, the sum of
\$2,000.00 per annum and after six months of such service
the sum of \$2,500.00 per annum, for each succeeding year.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances
in conflict with this ordinance or any part of it are hereby
repealed as to the conflicting portions, and that this
ordinance shall take effect when same is published and
adopted as required by law.
